May include completed projects or those still in process.

Eligibility:

Open to Family Medicine Residents, Fellows and Medical Students interested in Family Medicine in the state of New Mexico

Submission Deadline:

Monday Nov 19th, 2018

Notification of acceptance:

Friday December 21st, 2018

Submission guidelines:

Applicants will submit either an abstract or short write-up of their project in the following format: (all 2000 character limit)

1. For Works-In-Progress:
 - a. Please briefly describe your project, subjects, expected outcomes, and why this is relevant to Family Medicine.
2. For Completed Research Projects:
 - a. Purpose/Background: Describe the issue addressed and any relevant background information
 - b. Methods: Describe the project, participants, setting, interventions, measures, outcomes, and analyses
 - c. Results: Principal findings
 - d. Conclusions/Discussion
3. For clinical vignettes
 - a. Case Presentation: Please briefly describe your clinical case
 - b. Discussion: Why is this case important, what did you learn? Why is it relevant to Family Medicine?
 - c. Conclusion: What are your take home points and how can this case be used to change future clinical practice?
